Student Participation

2078 Indigenous Students Participated in LoCP activities this period (1390 Females, 1377 Males)

815 Target Student Cohort participated in LoCP activities as a core component of their studies*

692 Days of on-country camps, field trips and ranger activities were delivered with Traditional Owners, Rangers and Senior Knowledge holders

The NIAA KPI P206.02 Participation in Service target (1980 students) has been exceeded by 31.2% (or 494 students).

28 LoC students were engaged in Work Experience, Work Placements or Internships this period.

17 LoC students transitioned into employment this period.

24 LoC students graduated with their NTCET this period.
